



## ABSTRACT PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

### ORAL ABSTRACT PRESENTATION

The time available for the presentation is 8 minutes for the presentation and 4 minutes for the discussion. We recommend that, for a smooth development of the session and the attention of the attendees, you adjust the number of slides to the time given for your presentation.

You should test your presentation in the Speaker's Room with a technician at least 2 hours before the start of your session, or the day before if the session starts at 09:00 h.

You will also have the possibility to **upload your presentation through a secure platform**, for which you will receive an email in May with your passwords to log in. You can download the presentation template in the website.

You can also consult the **Presentation Guidelines for Speakers**, available on the congress website. Please check it thoroughly before preparing your presentation.

Remember that as first author you must be registered for your abstract to be considered as presented.

### CHAIRED POSTER

The poster (format A0 vertical (0.841 m. wide x 1.189 m. high)) should be hung in the indicated panel, in the Poster area:

**Thursday session:** between 08:30 h and 18:00 h on Wednesday 26th of June, and must be removed between 16:30 h and 18:30 h on Thursday 27th of June.

**Friday session:** between 08:30 h and 12:00 h on Friday 28th of June, and should be removed between before 12:30 on Saturday 29th of June.

The time available for presentation is 4 minutes (2 minutes for the presentation and 2 minutes for the discussion).

The Congress secretariat offers you a printing service, transfer and placement of your poster in the corresponding panel for a fee of 50€. To take advantage of this service you must upload your poster file in PDF format A0 vertical (0.841 m. wide x 1.189 m. high) before **June 12th**, to the platform, which you will access with the user and password that we will send you in May. Please note that once uploaded to your private area, it cannot be modified, so we advise you to check your poster carefully before sending it. You can download the official poster template in the website.

Remember that as first author you must be registered for your abstract to be considered as presented.

## POSTER

The poster (format A0 vertical (0.841 m. wide x 1.189 m. high)) should be hung in the indicated panel, in the Poster area:

**Poster I:** Between 08:30 h and 18:00 h on Wednesday 26th of June, and must be removed between 16:30 h and 18:30 h on Thursday 27th of June.

**Poster II:** Between 08:30 h. and 12:30 h. on Friday 28th of June, and must be removed between 09:00 h. and 12:30 h. on Saturday 29th of June.

The Congress secretariat offers you a printing service, transfer and placement of your poster in the corresponding panel for a fee of 50€. To take advantage of this service you must upload your poster file in PDF format A0 vertical (0.841 m. wide x 1.189 m. high) before **June 12th**, to the platform, which you will access with the user and password that we will send you in May.
